Is that your “Other” Facebook?

Like it or not Social Networking is here to stay. More and more Christians are using social networking sites such as Facebook, MySpace, Google+ and Linked-In. Like all forms of online media they have their benefits. However, more and more Christians are falling into the pitfalls of these forms of media.

Does your Facebook reveal your “Other” face? It’s alarming how many professing Christians use Facebook in posting unseemly pictures or promoting an ungodly lifestyle. I’ve seen professing Christians post how much they love the Lord and then in the next post promote what wicked TV show they’ll be watching that night which promotes fornication and homosexuality. *Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be. (James 3:10)*

Facebook for example allows you to create groups of friends as well as hide things posted in one group so that another group cannot see. This type of behavior is deceptive.

Then said he unto me, Son of man, dig now in the wall: and when I had digged in the wall, behold a door. And he said unto me, Go in, and behold the wicked abominations that they do here. (Ezekiel 8:8-9). The context of this passage reveals how the priests were attempting to hide their wickedness behind closed

doors and in the dark. God was judging Jerusalem not only for their wickedness that was in the open for all to see, but also where only the Lord sees, behind closed doors and in the dark. The Lord knoweth.

As a pastor, there to me is nothing more discouraging than to see those I have the blessing to pastor use social networking to promote ungodliness. What message does this send not only to your fellow believers, but the lost world?

And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them. For it is a shame even to speak of those things which are done of them in secret. (Ephesians 5:11-12)

Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, (2 Corinthians 6:17)

So how will you use social networking? Will it be for the glory of God or the promotion of the Wicked One?

As for me, I deleted my Facebook account. It’s sad, but I prefer not to know what many professing Christians are doing outside of Church. It just became too discouraging.

Mission Field Update from Thailand

Please pray for our people as they adjust to this situation, that there would be no further damage to our building, and that God would use us to reach others at this time.

Flood Update:

It has been heartbreaking to see the devastation of the floods. Now more than one-third of Thailand is flooded, and there doesn't appear to be any signs of the rains easing. They are now extremely concerned that Bangkok will be flooded towards the end of this week, early next week.

The levy wall, which surrounded our city of Nakhon Sawan, broke three days ago. This has inundated the whole city with water. Our newly completed church refurbishment has been

flooded. The church, which was almost ready for opening, now has about a meter and half of water inside. The new chairs which were delivered on Saturday, along with the pulpit and curtains, have all been moved to the second level of the building. If the waters continue rising, then the sound system and electrical will be at risk. The church and most of the city is now only accessible by boat.

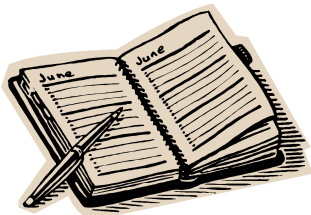
